

The Second Aspect: The Cross of Christ

Our second problem is
that being spiritually dead
– we need life!

Not only did Christ die for our sins, but if we have believed on Him as our Savior, the old person we were in Adam also died with Him. Then we as new creations rose with Him, that being no longer “in Adam” but “in Christ” we might now walk in newness of life.

By our being crucified with Christ
we have been released from the
power of sin as the source of our
sins.

Christ has imparted to us His Life – Eternal Life – so that He might live out His life through us as we yield ourselves to Him and trust His enabling presence rather than relying on our own resources.
